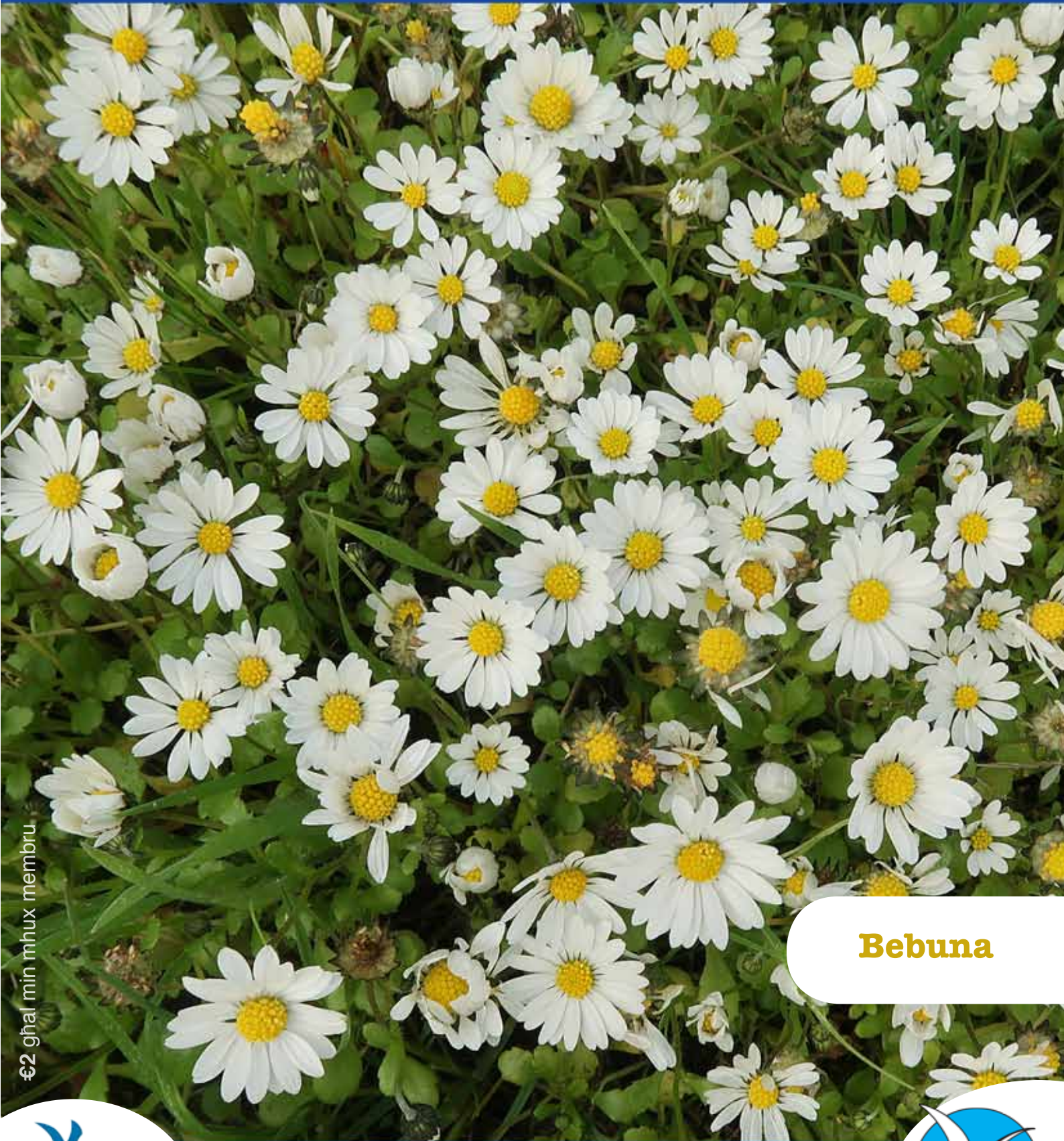

Iz-zakak abjad (*white wagtail*) iżurna fil-ħarifa – jiġu bl-eluf. Ħafna minnhom jieqfu ftiit jistrieħu imbagħad ikomplu jtiru lejn l-Afrika. Ohrajn jieqfu u jgħaddu x-xitwa magħna. Matul il-jum jinfirxu mal-kampanja jfittxu dud u insetti żgħar fir-raba' u anke mal-ġnub tat-toroq. Imma fil-ġaxija jingabru f'numru kbir biex jorqdu flimkien f'xi siġar li jkunu għall-kenn. Dawn il-postijiet speċjali ngħidulhom *roosts*, u l-ikbar wiehed f'pajjiżna qiegħed il-Belt Valletta, sewwasew fis-siġar fi Pjazza Assedju faċċata tal-Qorti!

Kull sena l-BirdLife torganizza attività biex tgħodd iz-zizka li jidhru jorqdu l-Belt. L-ikbar numru li qatt tellajna kien is-sena l-oħra: 14,475 zakak. Din is-sena n-numru kien inqas, imma xorta total sabih ta' **10,366** zakak. Dan kien it-tielet l-ikbar total minn meta bdejna nagħmlu dawn ir-roost counts fl-1986.

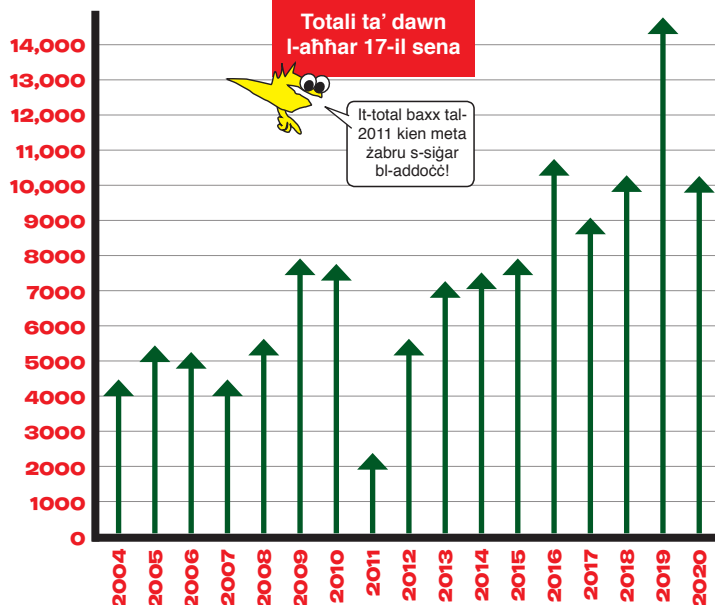

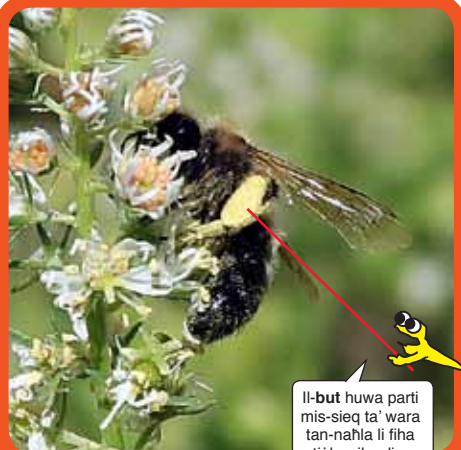

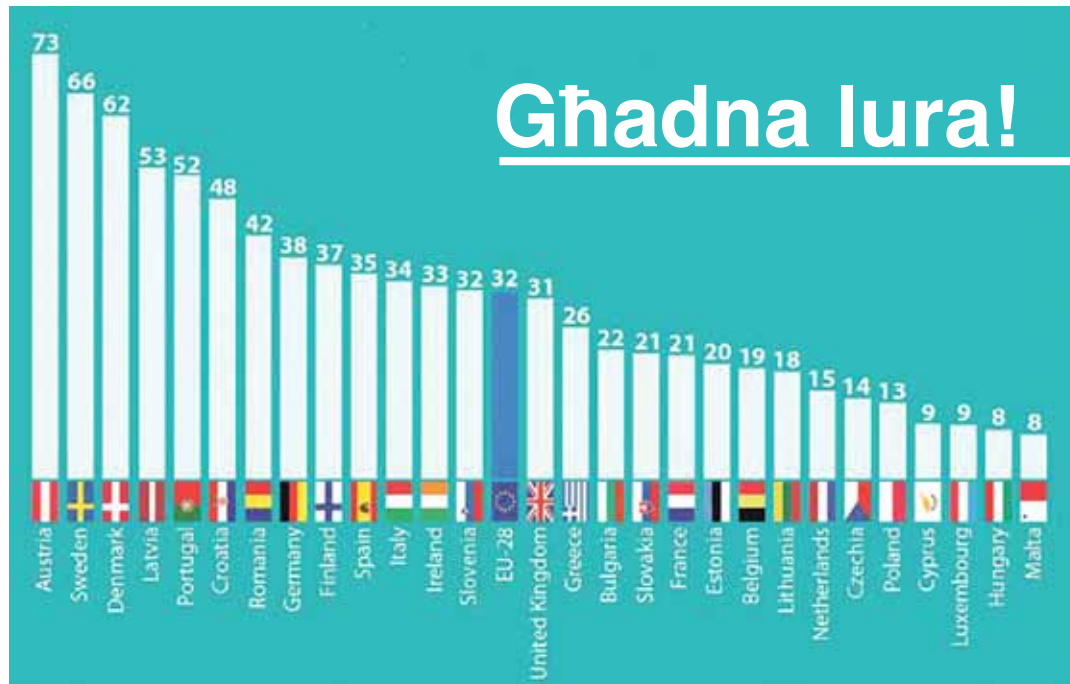

Iż-żring (*painted frog*) huwa l-uniku amfibju 'indigenu ta' Malta. Jgħix f'nixxighat, vaski u ġwiebi, basta jkun ilma helu. F'dan l-ambjent iż-żring jiekol insetti żgħar bħal nemus. Iż-żring ibid ukoll fl-ilma, li minnu jfaqqsu l-imrieżeb (*tadpoles*). Sa ma jikber, il-marżebb jgħix fl-ilma u jieħu n-nifs mill-ilma bħall-hut. Jiekol billi jnaqqar mill-pjanti tal-ilma. Huwa u jikber u jrabbi s-saqajn ikabbar ukoll il-pulmun f'sidru biex meta jsir żring ikun jista' jieħu n-nifs barra mill-ilma.

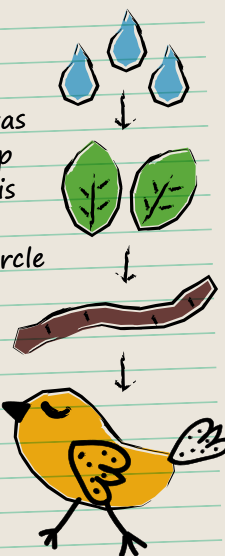
AMY'S DIARY

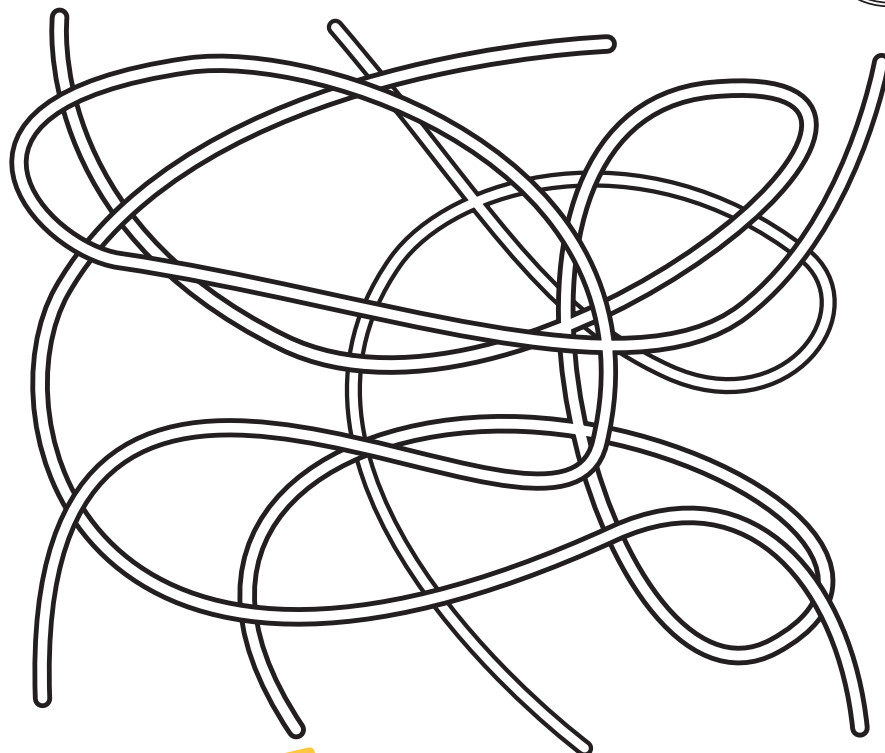


But anyhow, Charlie took a liking to Travvy, and just could not understand why I couldn't spare one piggy bank when I had 4!

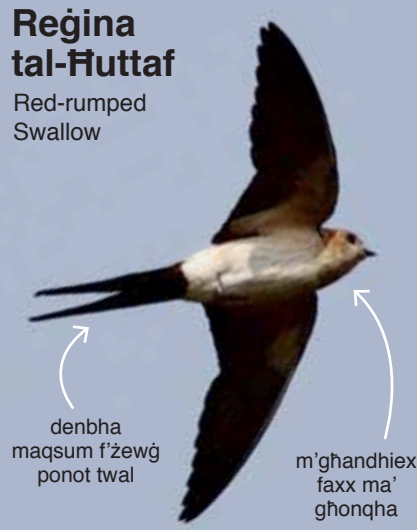

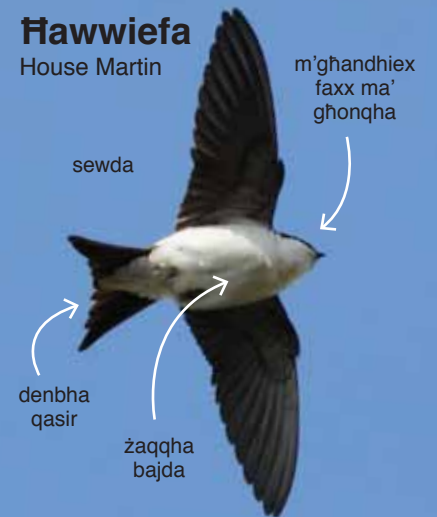

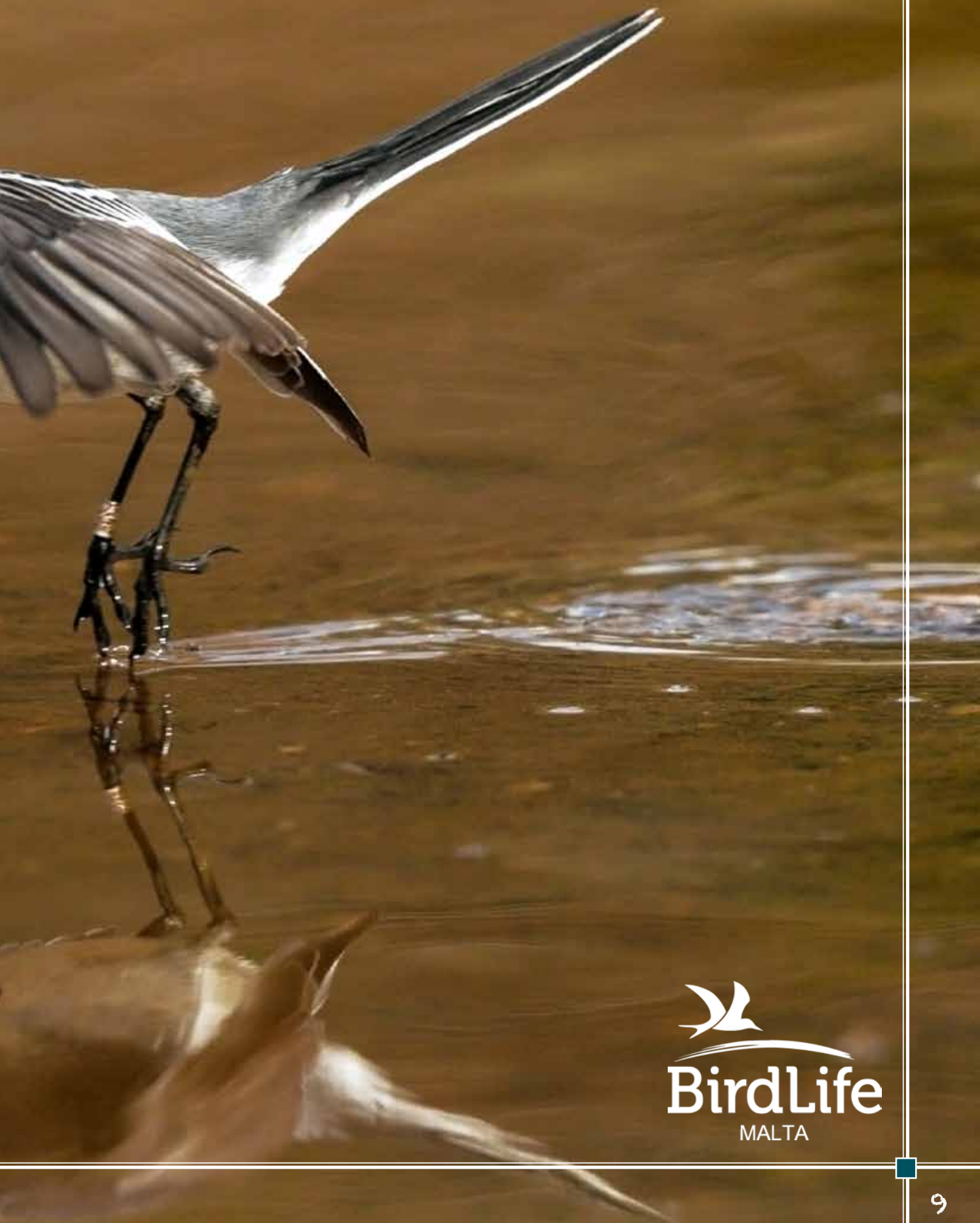

DO YOU WANT TO FIND NEMO, THE CLOWNFISH?



THEN YOU BETTER LOOK CLOSELY IN SEA ANEMONES (EVEN THOUGH THEY DO NOT HAPPEN IN MALTA)!

WHY DO THEY STAY THERE?

By hiding among the anemones' tentacles, the clownfish receives protection from predators and also ends up eating the anemone's food leftovers. They actually can't survive out of the anemone!

DON'T THEY GET STUNG?

Sea anemones have stinging tentacles that are used to immobilise their prey. However, clownfish have mucus outside their skin that protects them from being stung!



THEY CAN CHANGE SEX!

Clownfish live in groups of one dominant female (the largest fish in the group), one adult male and other immature juveniles. If the female dies, the male will become a female to replace her leading position, and the largest undifferentiated juvenile will become the new male of the group!

DO ANEMONES BENEFIT TOO?

Yes! Some species of clownfish are very territorial and defend their anemone from predators. They also pick away parasites from the anemone, and the fish's waste give essential nutrients to the anemone.

A walk at Tal-Wej

Tal-Wej... what a strange name! Many people have no idea where the place is or even heard of it. But the hundreds of families who live around this green oasis are proud of their very own nature park. And if you like nature or archaeology, it's a great place for a walk.

So off I went for a walk there some days ago.

Nice and green

The first thing I noticed was how green the place was. It hadn't rained for weeks so I thought it would all be kind of drying up. But it wasn't, it was lush and full of wild flowers everywhere.

What's that lovely call?

The second thing I noticed was the **meadow pipits** calling. They have this nice *Pss-wss-wss-wss-wss!* call that tells you they're around. And a good thing too, because meadow pipits are so hard to spot. They have great camouflage and you don't see them if they're on the ground among the plants. But I had my trusty binoculars, so I zoomed on a place where I heard some calls, and yup! I soon spotted two or

three walking about in a rocky field.

Looking for bugs and slugs, I'm sure.

And that other nice call?

But now there was another bird calling. Another small bird, but very different from the meadow pipit – this one was going *wss-chak! wss-chak! chak! wss-chak!* and I knew just where to look to find him. On top of that pile of stones? No! Top of that shrub? No! Top of that tall dry stalk? Aha! Black head, rusty breast... yesss, a lovely male **stonechat**.

Trumpets, bees, fans and vipers!

I walked along the stony path, with lots of flowers growing on each side. There was a row of lovely **red campion** flowers waving in the breeze, and **cape sorrel** with yellow trumpet flowers. Some flowers had **honey-bees** stuck half-way in drinking the sweet nectar. There were also lots of **borage**, with big bristly leaves and blue

And just as I was getting up, I came face to face with a lovely **fan-lipped orchid**. Just one. So pretty, so delicate and so rare. And so easy to miss.

An ancient tomb

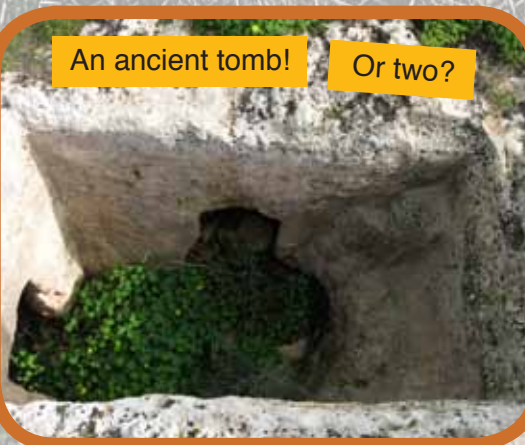
I walked to a rocky patch. There were some **ancient square holes** cut in the ground. I wonder how old they were, and what they were for. There was an **old stone tomb** nearby too. Wow, the ancient people cut all that rock without power tools!

And there were **ancient cart ruts** too, right across the path. If you like archaeology (like me), Tal-Wej is a great place to visit.

Then I walked to a place where there's usually a nice big pond, where I knew a strange ancient creature lives: the **tadpole shrimp**. But when I got there there was no pond... just a dry patch with dry mud at the bottom. Ah, but in that dry mud there are the eggs of the shrimp, lying there waiting for the rain. And when it rains the eggs will hatch and grow into shrimps. And they too

will lay eggs! Well I hope so because the tadpole shrimp is mega-rare and almost extinct from Malta.

Cissik! Cissik! A **white wagtail** zoomed by and landed ten metres away, bobbing its long tail up and down. Maybe he too hoped to find the pond. Wagtails love to walk around the edge of a pond looking for tiny creepy crawlies to eat. Sorry friend, no luck this time!

Queen of flowers

It was time to head back home. But as I looked about through my binoculars one last time I saw a violet spot in a patch of yellow flowers. I walked to the patch and yayy! it was a **crown anemone** – a queen among flowers. I was so excited because I hadn't seen one in three years. And around it... a whole patch of them. Awesome!

NATIONAL SPECIES

WE ARE SO LUCKY! Lucky that in Malta we share our lives with so many different types of plants and animals. Each one with its own unique qualities. Some of these flora and fauna are indigenous while others are endemic. But what does this really mean?

When a species is indigenous it is naturally found in one country but can also be found in other countries. On the other hand, an endemic species can only be found naturally within its country of origin. This makes them very unique and also very special!

Five of these types of species have been crowned as National species. Meaning that not only is there a law that protects them, but that they have been recognised as species which remind you of Malta and our Maltese identity. The National species of the Maltese Islands are the Mediterranean Killifish, the Maltese Freshwater Crab, the Maltese Rock Centaury, the Sandarac Gum Tree and the Blue Rock Thrush.
