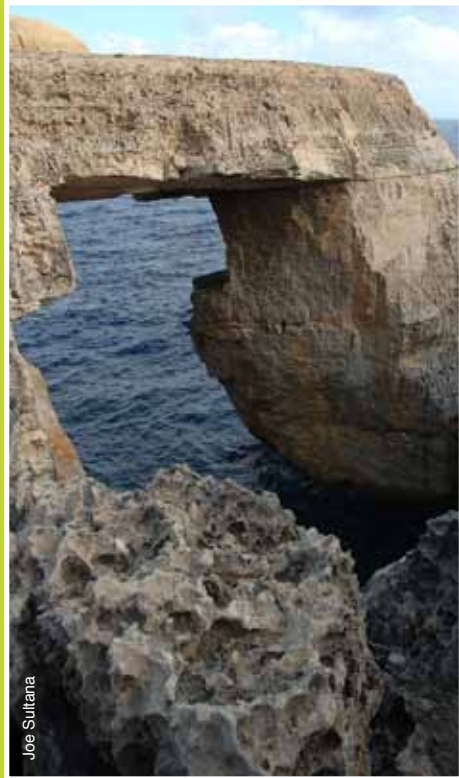

Tliet siti Natura 2000 ġodda

Siti Natura 2000 huma biċċiet art jew baħar li fihom in-natura tkun imħarsa minn żvilupp bl-addoċċ. F'Malta għandna 48 minnhom, 34 fuq l-art u 14 fil-baħar. U issa s-siti ta' fuq l-art ser jiżiedu bi tliet inħawi ġodda. Dawn huma **Wied Ħas-Saptan** (hdejn Marsaxlokk), **Wied il-Mielah** (f'Għawdex) u **Tal-Wej** (hdejn il-Mosta).

Kumbinazzjoni dwar Tal-Wej ktibna m'ilux f'*Il-Huttafa*. Tabilhaqq post li jixraqlu ħarsien għan-natura u l-istorja tiegħu. Wied il-Mielah huwa wied fond b'ħafna xagħri madwaru (u tieqa fil-blat), u Wied Ħas-Saptan jista' jkun ġenna tal-art għan-natura jekk jingħata l-kura li haqqu. Iktar 'il quddiem ngħidulkom iktar dwar dawn is-siti ġodda protetti. Prosit!

Il-fekruna terġa' tbejjjet!

Il-fekruna tal-baħar reġgħet biedet fuq ramla Maltija... anzi biex inkunu iktar preċiżi ramla Għawdxija.

Fid-29 Mejju, għall-ħabta tal-10pm, xi nies li kienu r-Ramla l-Ħamra raw **fekruna tal-baħar** (loggerhead turtle *Caretta caretta*) tielgħa l-art, tħaffer fir-ramel, tbid partita bajd, tgħattihom u terġa' lura fil-baħar. Waww! B'xorti tajba dawk li rawha kellhom id-diċenza ma jfixkluhiex. Prosit!

F'dawn l-aħħar snin il-fekruna tal-baħar biedet tliet darbiet f'pajjiżna – darbtejn fil-Ġnejna (fl-2012 u

fl-2018, ara *Il-Huttafa* 111 u 147) u darba fir-Ramla tal-Mixquqa fl-2016 (ara *Il-Huttafa* 135). F'Għawdex kien ilu xi 70 sena ma titla' fekruna l-art. Għalhekk is-sbejha li biedet fir-Ramla tatna pjaċir doppju, mhux biss għax żanznet ramla oħra, imma wkoll għax ma setgħetx tagħzel xatt aħjar. Ir-Ramla l-Ħamra hija l-ikbar

ramla li għandna fil-Gzejjer Maltin. Barra minn hekk hija sit Natura 2000, jiġifieri protetta minn żviluppi bħal lukandi u bini ieħor. Insomma għamlet għażla għaqlija l-fekruna!

Issa nittamaw li kollox imur b'wiċċ il-ġid, u li f'*Il-Huttafa* li jmiss inħabbru kemm faqqsu fkejruni u kemm ġrew lejn il-baħar :).

Indiġenu (*indigenous or native*)

Speċi indiġena tfisser speċi li dejjem kienet teżisti f'dak il post, fi kliem ieħor ma jkunx dahħalha l-bniedem minn post ieħor. Għalhekk pereżempju s-siġra tal-ballut hija indiġena għal pajjiżna għax meta wasal il-bniedem Malta kienet diġà hawn tikber selvaġġ. U bħalma hija indiġena f'Malta l-balluta hija wkoll indiġena f'ħafna nħawi oħra tal-Mediterran. WE HAVE WILD DOLPHINS IN MALTA!



Dolphins (dniefel) are mammals and there are different species all year that swim around the Maltese archipelago. The common bottlenose dolphin is the most frequent of them! However, with the COVID-19 outbreak, more sightings of dolphins were recorded in the Maltese islands...

IS THE PANDEMIC CHANGING THEIR BEHAVIOUR?

Possibly they are coming closer to shore due to the reduction in underwater noise. But the question is: will this last long? Studies have yet to be developed so we can differentiate short-term effects from long-term alterations in their behaviour.

DO THEY MAKE SOUNDS?

Yes! Dolphins make different types of sounds like clicks and whistles so they can communicate with each other by echolocation - similarly to bats! This is probably why they are coming closer to shore... it's quieter so they communicate better and explore new places without the risk of for instance being hit by a boat!



HOW MANY DOLPHINS DO WE HAVE IN MALTA?

We also have species like the Risso dolphin, the short beaked common dolphin and the striped dolphin, but the common bottlenose dolphin is the most sighted. Its population is estimated to range from 79 to 224 in and around Maltese waters (79 being the most realistic figure).

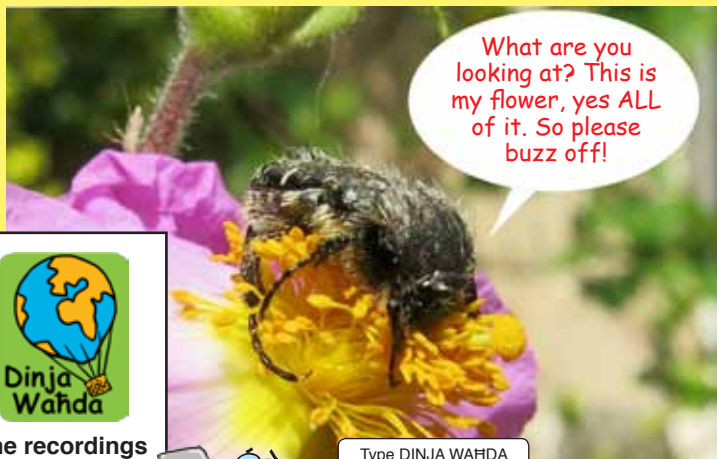

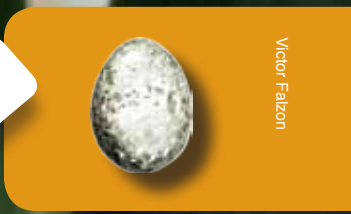

MALTESE ROCK-CENTAURY

WE ARE SO LUCKY! Lucky that in Malta we share our lives with so many different types of plants and animals some of which have been crowned as National species. In this issue we are featuring the Maltese Rock-Centaury (*Palaeocyamus crassifolius*), popularly known as widnet il-baħar.

WHERE IS IT FOUND?

This plant can be found in cliffs and boulder scree and flowers from May to July. It is also used in public gardens, as well as urban and rural landscaping.

The Maltese Rock-Centaury was declared as the national plant in 1971. ERA gave it additional protection as a national species in 2018.*

IS IT PROTECTED?



IS IT ENDEMIC?

Yes, this endangered plant is endemic to the Maltese Islands. This means that it can only be found here and nowhere else in the world.
