

fl-istess inħawi. Imma f'ċerti kundizzjonijiet tat-temp kultant jitfaċċaw barra minn posthom. Meta dawn it-tnejn tfaċċaw f'pajjiżna, il-berdwoċers Maltin tahom ferħ ta' ġenn!

Żjara minn Ġgant!

Hafna nies jafu li fil-baħar madwar Malta jidhru d-dniefel. Li hafna ma jafux hu li kultant jidhru wkoll il-kuġini l-kbar tagħhom: il-balieni!



Fjuri s-sena kollha

Min jagħmel ġnien għan-natura jkabbar pjanti apposta biex dawn jibdew il-ktajjen tal-ikel. Imma kif tagħżel meta hawn tant pjanti? Hawn xi suġġerimenti biex jgħinuk tagħżel...



L-ewwel holqa

Kif nitghallmu fil-lezzjonijiet tax-xjenza, il-pjanti huma l-ewwel holqa fil-ktajjen tal-ikel (*food chains*). Fil-ġnien xejn inqas. Mingħajr pjanti ma tħalliha ja' tkollna ħajja.

Waħda mill-iktar partijiet importanti tal-pjanti hija l-fjura. In-nektar li jagħmlu l-fjuri huwa l-ikel ta' ħafna insetti. Għalhekk **jekk fil-ġnien trid l-inseSSI s-sena kollha, ara li jkollok fjuri s-sena kollha!**

Aġħmel kalendarju

Aġħmel kalendarju bl-ismijiet tal-pjanti li tixtieq u ż-żmien li jkunu bil-fjuri. Jekk tara li għandek xi xħur bla fjuri, ibqa' fittekk sakemm issib pjanti adattati, u ftit ftit imla l-vojt.

Hafna mill-pjanti i'indiġeni Maltin jagħmlu l-fjuri fir-rebbiegħa, qis u minn Frar sa Mejju. Fix-xhur l-oħrajin l-għażla hija hafna iż-ġieħi. Allura biex ikollna l-fjuri s-sena kollha kultant ikollna nżewqu ftit b'xi pjanti eżotici. - Iċċekkja f'liema żmien tagħmel il-fjuri ħalli tidħol fil-kalendaru tal-ġnien.



Hawn diversi tipi ta'lantana imma mhux kollha jiġbdu l-insetti. L-ahjar ghall-friefet, naħal u baħrijet hija r-razza tal-bukketti roża bi ffit isfar. Tagħmel fjuri s-sena kollha u tikber forma ta' arbuxell kbir li faċċi tagħmlu ħeġġ. Iż-żerriegħa jistgħu jgorruha l-annimali imma fil-klima tagħna mhix invaživa.



il-pjombina

Il-pjombina tajba ħafna għall-friefet il-blu u għandha staġun twil bil-fjuri. Jibdew minn April u l-pjanta tibqa' twarrad sakemm it-temp jaqleb f'Novembru. Tista' tikber bħala arbuxell jew ixxebligha ma' ħajt b'kannizzata, jew isserraħha fuq čint. Mhix invaživa.



il-kažmante

Il-kažmanti hija waħda mill-ftit pjanti li jkollha l-fjura fix-xitwa li jibqgħu jifthu sar-rebbiegħha. Dawn il-pjanti tal-basla joħorġu fil-ħarifa u sa Jannar ikunu bil-fjuri. Il-fjuri jkollhom ħafna nektar fi żmien meta l-ġnien ffit li xejn ikollu fjuri. Anke għasafar żgħar bħall-vjolin tax-xitwa jixrob mill-fjuri. Taf tkun invaživa imma ż-żerriegħha faċċi tneħħiħielha qabel ma ssir.



il-pittosporum

Arbuxell kbir u folt li jsebbaħ bid-dehra tal-weraq skur ileqq. Kmieni fir-rebbiegħha timtela fjuri f'bukketti bojod jew safranin ifuħu, u jżuruha naħal u baħrijet, ilkoll jixorbu mill-ħafna nektar li jagħmlu l-fjuri. Il-pittosporum tintużha ħafna bħala ħeġġ. Mhux invaživ.

Arbuxell mir-razza tal-honeysuckle imma iktar goffa. Tikber ġmielha u tiffolta, imma tista' żżommha wkoll bħala ħeġġ. Tagħmel fjuri mir-rebbiegħha tul is-sajf kollu sakemm jiffriska t-temp. Iħobbuha diversi naħal u bombli għax tagħmel ħafna nektar. Mhix invaživa.



Naħla fuq fjuri tas-salvia

RIHA tfuħ, TOGHMA tajba u INSETTI kemm trid!

Hemm grupp pjanti li nsejħulhom **aromatici** għax il-weraq tagħhom ifuħ. Peress li anke t-togħma tal-weraq tagħhom togħġobna, ħafna minn dawn il-pjanti jitkabbru fil-ġonna. B'xorti tajba ħafna minnhom tajbin ukoll għall-insetti. Fost il-ħnejjex aromatici nsibu n-nagħniegħ (spearmint), il-ħabaq (basil), ir-riegnu selvaġġ (oregano), il-merqtux (marjoram), it-tursin (parsley), il-karfus (celery) u s-salvja (sage). Ħafna minn dawn l-ispeċi m'humiex indiġeni imma ilhom jitkabbru Malta mijiet tas-snin, u mhumiex invaživi. Jibdew bil-fjuri minn April u wħud jibqgħu bil-fjuri sa tard fil-ħarifa. Ftit hawn pjanti Maltin li fis-sajf ikunu bil-fjuri, għalhekk b'taħħita ta' ħnejjex aromatici sejkollok gnien ħajt anke fix-xhur sħan.

Ahh! Nagħniegħ, habaq, tursin... Qed iqabbdu aptit għal hobża biż-żejt!



BEHIND THE SCENES AT THE MALTA NATIONAL AQUARIUM



MALTA NATIONAL
AQUARIUM

Even when the Malta National Aquarium is closed to the public, the Back of House team (our aquarists) keep working as hard as ever to keep the animals safe and happy! They usually study marine biology or related areas, and are very passionate about our ocean. Maybe you might get inspired to follow a career in the field too! Find out a bit of what happens behind the scenes here, not only during shutdown but every single day since we opened:

Quarantine

This is where the new fish that arrive at the Aquarium go to! We can't put them directly in the tanks because they have to be monitored just in case they have any disease or parasites. During this time, the new fish will also get adjusted to the new type of water and food they will receive from us. Oh, and the quarantine also acts like a "spa" for the new fish, which are stressed from transport and relocation!



Food preparation room

This place is where the aquarists stock and prepare the food for the animals. Most of the food that we use is frozen since it's easier to maintain and it doesn't contain blood or parasites. Then we defrost it, clean it, and chop it in different sizes. There is a weekly schedule for all the different animals - some of them are fed everyday, others every other day, etc... it all depends on their nutritional and individual needs.




Laboratory and filtering system

Every tank has its own water conditions and the water parameters need to be the same all the time. The aquarists keep a long-term record on things like temperature, salinity, oxygen concentration, ammonia, nitrite, nitrate and pH. They also look like scientists when they are checking tiny critters under the microscope!

Filters are also essential to the health of the tanks. They keep the water in good quality and the tank's inhabitants healthy. In fact, every single tank in the Aquarium has its own filtration system!

Deep cleaning is also done by diving in the larger tanks... including the ones with sharks!

FUN FACT:
All the food we give to the fish is marinated in GARLIC to boost their immune system! Yummy!

Posidonia & Sandbanks



Seagrasses grow and form habitats in seawater but are still closely related to plants on land. They are known as the 'lungs of the sea' because they release oxygen that is used by other organisms.

In addition, they stabilise the sediment preventing loss of our coastlines and beaches through erosion and combat climate change by acting as 'carbon sinks', meaning that they take up carbon dioxide thus reducing it from the atmosphere.


We have **two types** of seagrasses in Malta's coastal waters: the **Neptune grass (*Posidonia oceanica*)** and the **little Neptune grass (*Cymodocea nodosa*)**. Both species are legally protected also through the designation of Marine Protected Areas (MPAs).



The orange area shows the Marine Protected Areas in which **Posidonia** meadows and sandbanks are found.

The Neptune grass is endemic to the Mediterranean Sea. It can form dense meadows on the seabed at depths up to 50m. These meadows provide shelter and food to many animals, thus acting as an important nursery, even for fish that are eventually caught by fishermen. Its dead leaves are also important as they form deep layers called 'banquettes' along the coastline which protect against erosion and are in themselves also a habitat.

Little Neptune Grass is very similar to **Posidonia** however it has thinner leaves and does not form dense meadows. This species is found on expanses of sandy sediment on the seabed and is thus associated with sandbanks within our MPAs. This species acts as a **pioneering species**, stabilising the sediment and attracting other plants and animals forming complex ecosystems in the marine environment.




Little Neptune grass

Both habitats formed by the two seagrass species are considered to be important for maintaining a healthy marine environment and are generally used as indicators of the health status of our marine ecosystems.





Black-browed Babbler

It's always nice when everyone thinks an animal is extinct... and then someone spots it again!

That's what happened some months ago in the forests of Borneo, a huge island in Southeast Asia. Two men saw a strange bird but they didn't know what it was. They managed to catch the bird, took some pictures and set the bird free again. Nice men! They sent the photos to bird experts, and the experts could believe their eyes. The bird was a **black-browed babbler**, and nobody had seen one since 1840!

The black-browed babbler is still in danger of going extinct because the huge forests of Borneo are being chopped down.

A forest burning

We always say that the Amazon rainforest gives us oxygen and takes away the dangerous CO₂ gas from the air.

Well, in the rainforests of Brazil, **more CO₂ is now coming out than CO₂ going in**.

What! Have the trees gone crazy? No, it's not the trees' fault. It's the people who are burning millions of trees in the Amazon. When you burn wood, the carbon in the wood comes back out with the smoke.

In Brazil, people are now chopping and burning the forest **four times faster** than before. It's the people who are crazy, not the trees.

There are 22 species of albatrosses in the world – Wisdom is a **Laysan albatross**. She nests with other albatrosses on a tiny island called Midway, in the middle of the Pacific Ocean. In February she laid an egg and now the egg has hatched. Wisdom the proud mum is now looking after the new chick with proud dad

People who study Wisdom's life say this is maybe her chick number 40.

 But the rain makes everything so much more **LUSH!**


More greens for bugs to feed on, fatter insects for migrating birds to enjoy!

- L-isem xjentifiku huwa *Triops cancriformis*. Il-kelma *triops* tħisser ‘tliet għajnejn’, u dan l-annimal għandu fil-fatt tliet għajnejn!
- Bħall-gambli l-oħrajn, il-gamblu tal-elmu huwa fil-familja tal-annimali li fiha l-grancijiet u l-hnieżer l-art. Dan il-grupp jismu Crustacea.
- Fid-dinja ježistu xi 10 speċi ta' gamblu tal-elmu. F'Malta għandna biss speċi waħda.
- Il-gambli tal-elmu ilhom ježistu 300 miljun sena u dan nafuh mill-fossili li nstabu fi blat antik. Ilhom ježistu minn qabel id-dinożawri, u qabel ifforma l-blat tal-Gżejjer Maltin!
- Minħabba li l-gambli tal-elmu ftit inbidlu matul il-miljuni tas-snin, spiss jissejħu *living fossils*.

Il-gamblu tal-elmu jgħix f'għadajjar tax-xita, jiġifieri għadajjar li jinxfu fis-sajf. Dan l-annimal qed isir rari għax il-ħabitati tiegħu qiegħdin jinquerdu.

F'Malta wkoll il-gamblu tal-elmu huwa rari ħafna u jinsab biss f'xi żewġ inħawi. Qiegħed f'periklu serju li jsir estint.

Il-gamblu tal-elmu jiekol annimali żgħar tal-ilma bħal frieħ tan-nemus u briegħed tal-ilma, u anke xi algħi.

Qabel ma l-għadajjar jinxfu, il-gambli jħaffru fit-tajn u jbidu l-bajd fi. L-għadajjar jinxfu u l-għamblu jmutu, imma fit-tajn niexef jibqa' l-bajd, li jfaqqas meta terġa' tagħmel ix-xita.

F'Malta l-gamblu tal-elmu huwa mħares bil-liġi. Sfortunatament il-postijiet fejn jgħix għadhom mhumiex imħarsin sew.


