



The Maltese Top-Shell



The Maltese Top-shell also scientifically known as *Steromphala nivosa* is a threatened species, which is native to the Maltese islands.

This species is a small, attractively coloured, marine snail that was first described in 1851. Its size ranges between 3mm and 9mm and has a shell with brown with white squares arranged in rows especially at the shell's rounded base, with fine brown lines descending on the spiral conical-shaped shell.

Despite extensive efforts, no live individuals of this rare species were found between 1981 and 2005. Nevertheless, they were found in a variety of different locations between 2006 and 2010.



The Maltese Top-shell can be typically found in shallow seas up to five meters deep. Recent studies have discovered that cobble and pebble stone beds may be an important habitat for this species. They are also known to forage in *Posidonia oceanica* and *Cymodocea nodosa* seagrass beds.

Maltese Top-shells are a nocturnal species that wander through the night to find food and return during the day to avoid engaging with predators.



The Maltese Top-shell is considered as strictly protected through national, international and EU legislation. In fact, a number of Marine Protected Areas have been declared to protect this species and its habitats.

JAWSOME FACTS ABOUT SHARKS!

Malta hosts more than 30 species of sharks, but they stay far from the coast and in deeper waters than where we go swimming, so it is very unlikely to find one. Check the table to test your knowledge about them!



On the left we see the biggest type of shark: a whale shark, which can reach up to 12m! And, on the right, the smallest one, which can fit into a human hand: the dwarf lanternshark.



SHARKY FACT	TRUE	FALSE	WANNA KNOW WHY?
Sharks are fish that live in every ocean.	✓		A few sharks even swim up rivers, and at least one species (the bull shark) is sometimes found in freshwater.
All sharks look alike.	✓		Many kinds of sharks which live in the open ocean have torpedo-shaped bodies. However, they can also be flattened, more colourful, eel-like... it all depends on their habitat and lifestyle!
Sharks were around before dinosaurs.	✓		Most sharks, as we know them today, developed during the Cretaceous Period, about 64 million years ago - a time when dinosaurs still ruled the Earth!
Shark skeletons are made out of the same material as your nose and ears.	✓		A shark doesn't have one single bone in its body. Its skull, spinal column and fins' supports are made of cartilage!
All sharks have very sharp teeth.	✓		Each kind of shark has teeth suited to its lifestyle, being like a knife, a fork, sharp, rounded, flat, large, small... it all depends on what the shark eats!
Sharks have very poor eyesight.	✓		Most sharks see very well, especially the ones that live and hunt close to the surface. The ones who stay at the bottom or in dark and deep areas don't have to rely on sight as much as their other senses.
Some sharks lay eggs.	✓		Yup - and the fishermen call it the "mermaid's purse"! Some kinds of sharks, especially small sharks that live near the seafloor, lay eggs - but most sharks give birth to live young.
Sharks are dangerous.	✓		Definitely not! Of the more than 400 different kinds of sharks found in the ocean, only around 10 are most often involved in attacks/bad interactions with humans, especially the ones that people usually fear like the great white shark, the tiger shark and the bull shark. These accidents are also happening more often because we are destroying their environment, getting closer to their natural habitats and food chains are out of balance (so they get hungry!).
