Make a re-filling water tray

Age: 7-14

Topic: Biology and Art

Time: 1 hour



What equipment will I need?

- Plant pot saucer
- Large yoghurt pot
- Scissors
- Stone

How will learners explore this?

1. Cut a hole in the pot about 1cm from the top.
2. Fill the pot with water.
3. Put the saucer on the top and carefully turn everything upside down.
4. Place the stone on top of the saucer to keep your brand new water tray from filling over.

Top tips!

- To keep the water fresh for your bird friends, check your pot regularly.
- Why not use a water tub and collect rainwater to save the environment and your water bill?
