Position: Multimedia Communications Assistant

Dates: 1st November 2025 – 30th October 2026 (12 Months)

We are looking for a new full-time volunteer to join our international team protecting birds and their habitats and inspiring and educating people about birds and nature in the Maltese Islands. Volunteers will be based in our offices and at our nature reserves in Malta. Those who have previously participated in a long-term Erasmus+ European Voluntary Service (EVS) scheme or long-term Erasmus+ Volunteering scheme are not eligible to apply for these positions.

Are you:

- Aged 18-30
- A citizen of one of the [programme or partner countries](#)
- Outgoing, friendly, keen to meet new people, socialise, and experience a different culture
- Interested in improving bird, flora and other taxa identification skills
- Interested in inspiring and educating people about birds and the natural world
- Willing to develop administration, time management, numeracy, and interpersonal skills
- Willing to learn and having an adaptable approach in line with the needs of a charitable organisation's structure including working flexible and occasional long hours, which could include weekends and public holidays.

The European Solidarity Corps programme will provide you:

- Accommodation close to our offices in Ta' Xbiex/in the northern part of the island close to our nature reserves
- Utilities such as electricity, water, gas, and internet

- Reimbursement of the flight and other transport costs (bus, train, metro) to/from Malta, limited according to distance
- €380 monthly allowance
- Private HEALTH insurance provided by Henner

Position: Multimedia Communications Assistant (1 position)

Dates: 1st November 2025 – 30th October 2026 (12 Months)

The Multimedia Communications Assistant will assist in raising the profile of the organisation and its work through creative visual communications. Applicants are expected to have an interest in nature and the environment. The chosen applicant should have a good command of English. Proficiency in the use of Adobe InDesign, Photoshop and Premiere Pro is a must. Knowledge of Illustrator and CapCut is considered an asset. The volunteer will report directly to the Public Engagement Executive, fulfilling the following duties:

- Design BirdLife Malta's magazine using Adobe InDesign and other printed materials including promotional leaflets, banners, logos and educational materials
- Design and produce graphics and visuals for website, social media and advertising
- Edit photographs using Adobe Photoshop to be used in internal and external communication
- Produce and edit high-quality video content for local and international audiences using Adobe Premiere Pro and/or CapCut
- Attend public and press events as a photographer/videographer when required
- Manage video uploads and social media channels
- Archive, organise and upload multimedia content to the digital media library
- Play a key role in BirdLife Malta's migration camps (Spring Watch and Raptor Camp) by downloading and organising photos and footage from the conservation team and creating videos to distribute to the media
