AUTUMN HUNTING

Hunting on land

- The autumn hunting season is open from 1st September 2025 to 31st January 2026.
- Between 15th September 2025 and 7th October 2025, hunting is permitted from two hours before sunrise to 7pm.
- For the remainder of the season, hunting is permitted from two hours before sunrise until two hours after sunset.
- On Sundays and public holidays, hunting is not permitted after 1pm.
- Hunting at Majjistral Park is only allowed from two hours before sunrise until noon. However, on Wednesdays and public holidays, hunting is only allowed from two hours before sunrise until 10am.
- It is legal to hunt for 40 species from land. All other species are protected by national and international law.
- Out of these, European Turtle-dove (*Streptopelia turtur*) can only be hunted between 1st September 2025 and 30th September 2025.
- The overall bag limit for the autumn hunting season for European Turtle-dove is 500.
- It is illegal to hunt or possess a firearm or trapping equipment in a Bird Sanctuary (Table 1).
- It is illegal to use electronic callers.
- It is illegal to have a shotgun capable of firing more than three shots in succession.
- It is illegal to hunt within 50 metres of a main road.
- It is illegal to hunt within 50 metres of a beach (Table 2).
- It is illegal to hunt within 200 metres of a residential area (i.e. an area with more than 100 residents).
- It is illegal to hunt under the legal age of 18.

Hunting on sea

- Hunting of birds at sea is permitted between 1st October 2025 and 31st January 2026.
- It is illegal to hunt at sea within 3 km of the shoreline.
- It is legal to hunt for 12 species at sea. All other species are protected by national and international law.
